CRRSAA REPORTING ON EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS TO STUDENTS

Quarterly Report Ending 06/30/2021

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, and was signed into law on Dec. 27, 2020. In total, the CRRSAA authorizes \$81.88 billion in support for education. The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), provides an additional \$22.7 billion for the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). Funding from the CRRSAA is referred to as HEERF II.

Mandl acknowledges and the acceptance of CRRSAA funds from the US Department of Education/ DOE and as directed under Sec 314(d)(5). Mandl will provide at least the amount in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students as received under CRRSAA's Sec 314(a)(1) as that was required under the CARES ACT.

- I. This statement shall serve to acknowledge that our institution signed and returned to the US Department of Education the *Certification and Agreement – Proprietary Institutional Grant Funds for Students*. We further attest that our institution has used, and/or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under accordance with section 314 (d)(7)/ & sec 314(c)(3).
- II. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] CRRSAA Grants to Student is \$822,974.
- III. The total amount of the CRRSAA/HEERF II Financial Aid Grants distributed to students as of June 31, 2021, is \$349,200. Amount disbursed from 04/01/2021 - 06/31/2021 is \$349,200.
- IV. The estimated total number of students at our institution eligible to participate in the CRRSAA program under and thus eligible to receive emergency grant is 514.
- V. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under CRRSAA/HEERFII to date is 291. Number of students who received from 04/01/2021-06/30/2021 is 291.
