The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund HEERF II Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, and was signed into law on Dec. 27, 2020. In total, the CRRSAA authorizes \$81.88 billion in support for education.

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), provides an additional \$22.7 billion for the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). Funding from the CRRSAA is referred to as HEERF II.

Mandl acknowledges and the acceptance of CRRSAA funds from the US Department of Education/ DOE and as directed under Sec 314(d)(5). Mandl will provide at least the amount in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students as received under CRRSAA's Sec 314(a)(1) as that was required under the CARES ACT.

CRRSAA (HEERFII) funds allocated to Mandl School: \$822,974

CRRSAA (HEERF II) Available for Awards to Students: \$822,974

Mandl School was allocated \$822,974 in HEERF II funds. 100% of all funding allocated for HEERF II will be provided to students.

Mandl will make financial aid grants to students that can be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as; tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care.

Based on guidance, Mandl will prioritize funding to students with exceptional need, such as; students who receive Pell Grants. Students enrolled in Winter 2021 and/or Spring 2021 will be awarded a base amount of \$1200, who have exceptional need as defined as a Pell eligible EFC (2020-2021) or unmet need of greater than 20000 and who met all of the HEERF II requirements.

Additional CRRSAA funds of \$600 for independent students & \$250 for dependent student will be added to the base amount. Mandl has allocated 5% of the total HEERF II funds to make additional emergency awards to students who met the HEERF eligibility requirements.

The number of eligible students who meet census for the terms is projected at 489 based on enrollment threads that fluctuate. No application is necessary for students enrolled in the Winter & Spring of 2021. All CRRSAA funds will be awarded to students on a rolling basis until all funding is completely allocated.

Students will be notified by e-mail, by phone, and/or in person of CRRSAA awards. CRRSAA funds will be issued by check to students.
